- **Description:**

The course "Maritime Law" moves in the field of maritime law and thereupon, the law of the sea. As for the first, main issues concerning the ship are approached from a practical point of view, the carriers of maritime entrepreneurship and the relations among them on the one hand and one the other hand, theirs with the seafarers. In this way, among others, the concept of the ship is examined and the preconditions of the recognition of a ship as Greek, the concept of ship-owner, ship manager, charterer and co-ownership, as well as the constitution of a maritime labor contract and the rights of the captain and the crew that result from the contract. At a second level, the above mentioned concepts are linked with concepts of the international law of the sea.

- **Prerequisites:**

There are no prerequisites of attending another course in order to be able to respond to the requirements of the course. It is desirable that students attend courses of other cycles of study, relating to (private) Maritime Law. It is preferable however that students also attend the course of the International Law of the Sea to have a better grasp on the main concepts of both teachings.
