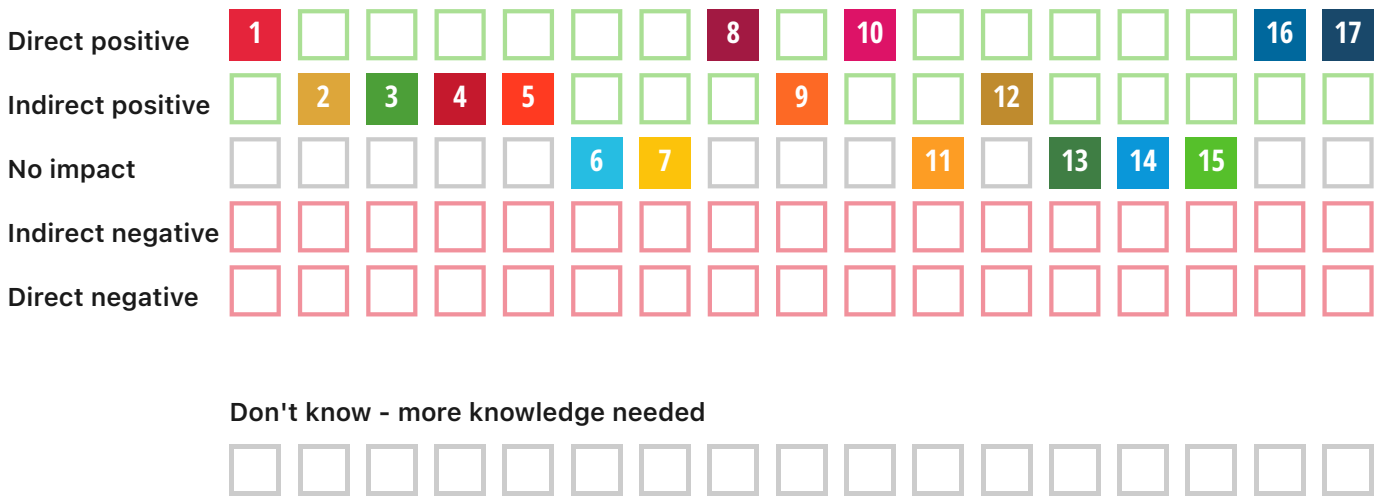




Special issues of financial law



Description

The course considers: Concept, function and parameters of competition. Relationship between unfairness and free competition. Meaning of morals users and instances of opposition to good morals. Especially the pricing and advertising of credit institutions. Unfair trade practices. Partnerships (vertical and horizontal) in competition law (1 Law 3959/2011). Abusive exploitation of a dominant position (2 Law 3959/2011). Abusive exploitation of a relationship of financial dependence (18a n146/1914). Business concentration. Market surveillance. Supervisory authorities and their operation. Sanctions (civil, administrative, criminal) in competition law and their enforcement procedure. In particular compensation claims for infringement of competition law rules (Directive 2014/104/EU).
