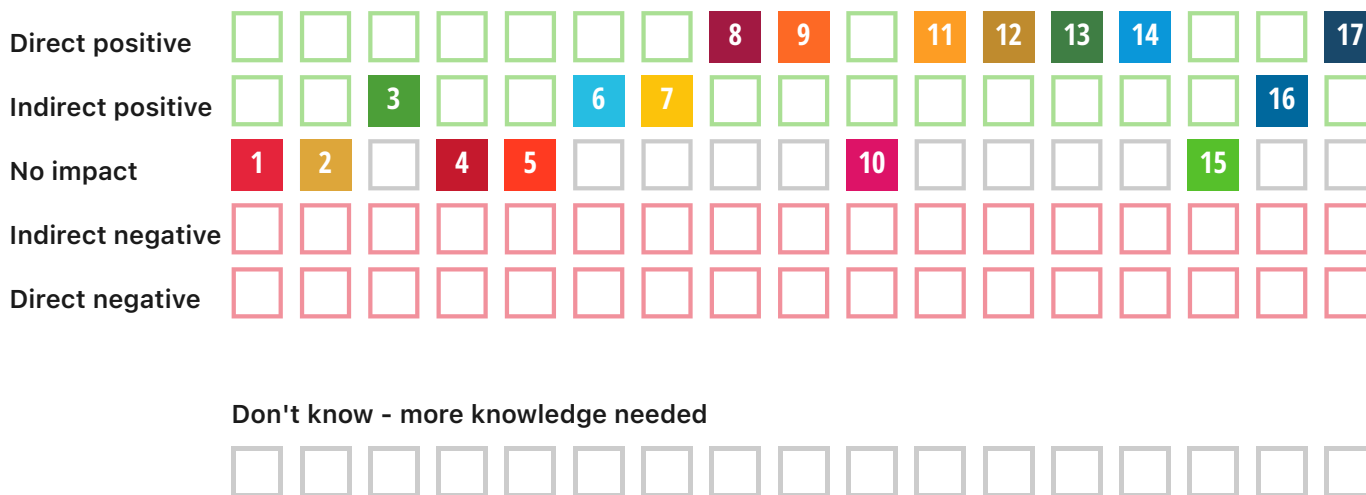




Operations in ports and terminals

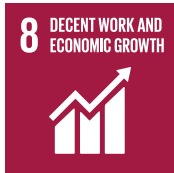
