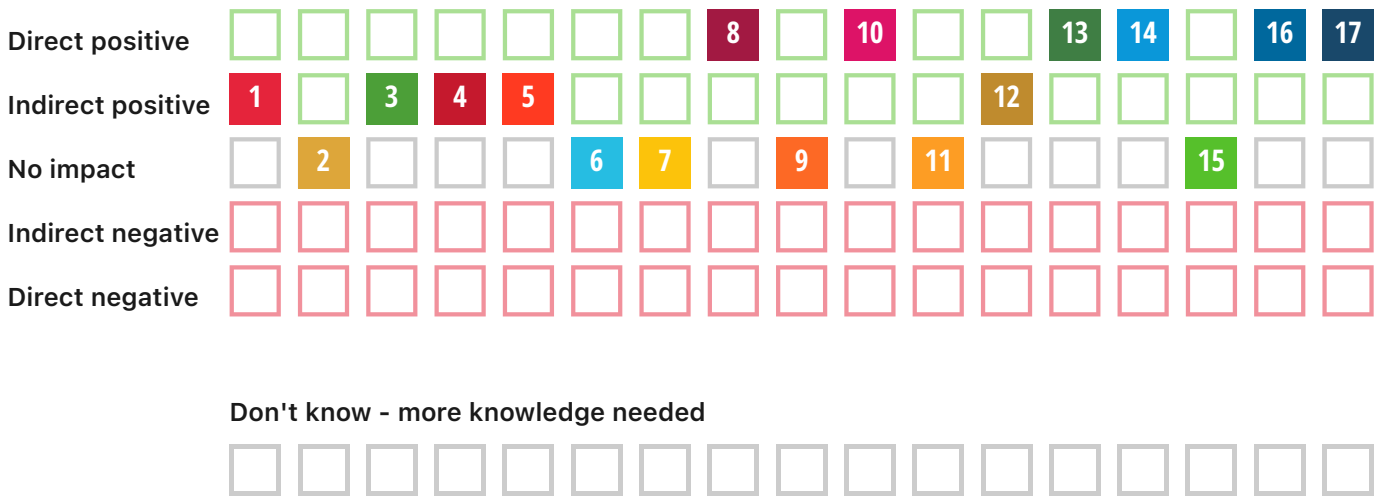




Sea Labour Law



Description

This course focuses on the law that regulates the rights and obligations of seafarers. In addition to national law, the regulations of European Law, International Conventions and jurisprudence are analyzed. Particular importance is given to the legal position of the Master and the crew during the performance of their duties, to the issues of wages and compensation in case of illness and accident as well as to the provisions of the Maritime Labor Agreement.
